PROPERTY COMMITTEE REPORT – January 2, 2023

H & S Plumbing provided an estimate for installing a garbage disposal in Zion's kitchen. This will be paid for with memorial funds from Maureen Holley's family and friends. Butler Heating and Cooling began work on installing the new boiler system on January 3rd. During the installation, worship services are being held in our Fellowship Hall. The monthly work list was completed. The committee will meet on Monday evening, February 6 at 6:00.

WORSHIP & MUSIC COMMITTEE - Wednesday, January 11, 2023 at 6 pm.

Attending were: Carla Frame, Susie Gray, Bill Jones, Deb Keppel, Kervyn Mach, and Lori Sebastian. Kervyn Mach began the meeting in prayer. We talked about upcoming dates. We will offer Sunday weekly communion weekly again starting January 29. Ash Wednesday is February 22 at 7pm. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday on April 1/2nd; Maundy Thursday is April 6 at 7pm, Good Friday is April 7 at 7pm, and the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday will be

April 8th/9th. We will have a Lenten Devotional Service sometime mid-March date and time to be determined.

For Christmas Eve and New Year's Services, thanks to the choir, Linda Holt, and Susie Gray/Lisa Sebastian for music. Christmas Eve, we had a good turnout in spite of the weather. New Year's attendance (Jan. 1st) was noticeably light.

Bill Jones and Susie Gray provided vocal choir updates. Bill is continuing to introduce hymns from All Creation Sings and use guitar. The choir has the last Weds. and Sunday of each month off. Bill announced Choir Sunday would be May 21st.

We had a group of kids randomly ring chimes on Away in a Manger Christmas Eve. We will plan to have a bell choir (music readers) in April.

Deb Keppel and Carla Frame provided Altar updates. The church (Women of Zion) are purchasing a new Christmas tree for the Chrismons. Carla held acolyte training for the youth Sunday, January 8th. Ashes are ordered for Ash Wednesday; palms are ordered for Palm Sunday. Deb will check with Linda Short on ordering Easter flowers.

For liturgy and service music, the canticles will change for Epiphany and Lent. We will continue using All Creation Sings. Lori has ideas for newsletter articles for February and March.

We discussed special music. The group wanted to see if Cove Springs could come on a Saturday or summer Sunday worship to sing / play music. We are considering hosting a Hearts, Hands, and Voices Workshop (sponsored by the Association of Lutheran Church Musicians) to help introduce All Creation Sings. Linda Holt said Adena Brass will provide some special music for Palm Sunday (April 2nd). We will continue to look at opportunities to bring some special music into Saturday services.

Remote Worship and Live Streaming report: We had about 20 people watching Christmas Eve live during broadcast (72 total afterwards). Most Sundays, Zion averages around 15 people watching over time. James Sebastian continues sending the recordings to the local television station.
